Junior Assembly "Boots and Bling" Party Information

WHEN: Friday, March 06, 2026

WHERE: Gilley's Dallas: 1135 Botham Jean Blvd, Dallas, TX 75215

SECURITY: For safety, there will be security officers, who will be securing the facility all evening. **We expect all members to behave respectfully and if for any reason your 8th grader is asked to leave the event, you will be contacted immediately and your child will not be invited to attend the next event. Please take the time to reminder your 8th grader of our rules...they will be strictly enforced.**

SIGN-IN: An authorized adult **MUST** park and come inside place to sign-in each JA Member(s) at the check-in table designated for his/her school (the "School Table"). **CARPPOOLING IS STRONGLY ENCOURAGED!** Carpooling should improve the traffic flow, especially during sign-in and sign-out. There is plenty of parking in the lots adjacent to the venue.

JA MEMBERS MUST LEAVE ALL PHONES, BACKPACKS, PURSES, OR OTHER BAGS AT THE SCHOOL TABLE IMMEDIATELY UPON ARRIVAL. Each JA Member will be handed a lanyard with his/her name on it to wear during the event.

JA Members will not have access to their phone prior to the authorized adult checking them out. If there is an **emergency** and you need to reach your JA Member before that time, please contact your school representatives, who will be on-site with their cell phones. **Your patience and understanding is appreciated during this process.**

SIGN-OUT: An authorized adult **MUST** park and come inside to sign-out each JA Member(s) who is riding home with him/her at the School Table. Upon check-out at the School Table, each JA Member turns in his/her lanyard and receives back personal items. **MAKE SURE ALL ITEMS ARE COLLECTED BEFORE LEAVING. Again, your patience and understanding is appreciated during this process.**

STANDING RULES: FOR THE SAFETY OF ALL STUDENTS, JA RULES WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED. Attached is the list of Standing Rules for Junior Assembly. Please review these with your son/daughter before the party.

JA Members who do not comply with the rules will be asked to leave the party. Parents will be called to pick up, and they will be dropped from membership without refund.
